REQUIREMENTS FOR PETS STAYING IN OUR FACILITY

For the safety of the staff and all pets staying in our facility, we require that all pets staying in the hospital must be current on all vaccines (rabies, distemper, and bordetella (dogs only)) and free from internal parasites (annual fecal examination required) and external parasites. For your convenience, if your pet is not current, or current records are unavailable, your pet will be examined and the appropriate vaccines and parasite treatment will be given while staying in the hospital. The examination, vaccines, and/or parasite treatment will be in addition to all other charges.

While staying at Grace Park Animal Hospital, we feed all pets Hill's Science Diet Maintenance formulas. If you would prefer to bring your own food, please be sure to label it clearly with your pet's name and the feeding requirements.

We always do our best to ensure the safe return of all items brought in at the time of boarding, however, Grace Park Animal Hospital will not be held liable for any items that are damaged, misplaced, or lost during your pet's stay. We are happy to provide blankets for your pets during their stay and recommend that you allow us to use our own bedding.

Reservations are recommended.

We will try to accommodate walk-ins, however, reservations will be honored first.
